

ISLAMIC EDUCATION LEARNING MANAGEMENT WITH AN INTEGRATED PROJECT-BASED MODEL RAHMATAN LIL ALAMIN

Skills such as critical thinking, creativity, problem-solving, collaboration, and digital literacy are intended to be enhanced through this model (Angraini et al., 2023) Educators can help students prepare for a changing world by choosing learning models that suit current needs and difficulties (Maryanto et al., 2023).

The project-based learning model is one of the learning models that can be used in the learning process. This model involves students in complex projects or assignments that require problem-solving and application of their knowledge in the real world (Amelia & Aisya, 2021). According to Nurasiah (2022) The project-based learning model (PjBL), also known as project-based curriculum, is an innovative learning model that emphasizes student-centered learning and encourages teachers to encourage students to solve problems.

Project-based learning helps students become more creative, critical, collaborative, communicating, and problem-solving. They also learn to work together in teams, share ideas, and solve problems (Taufiqurrahman, 2023). Additionally, as they present the results of their projects to classmates, teachers, or the community, they learn critical thinking, time management, and presentation skills. (Simamora, 2020). At educational unit levels such as junior secondary education, upper secondary education, and even higher education, this model is widely used. However, the application of project-based learning models in secondary education is very important. This model specifically helps students determine their life goals. (Triansyah et al., 2023).

The rapid growth of technology and global interconnection requires Islamic education to not only teach religious doctrine but also teach students practical and critical skills. To form a generation of Muslims who can contribute positively to society, it is very important to incorporate the concept of Rahmatan Lil Alamin, which prioritizes the principles of compassion, justice, and tolerance, into project-based education management. The Pancasila Student Profile and the Rahmatan Lil Alamin Student Profile are madrasah students who have the competencies and abilities as well as the Pancasila characteristics, are devout, have noble morals, and moderately practice religious values. (Ainissyifa et al., 2024). Pancasila and Rahmatan lil Alamin Student Profiles are people who think, act, and behave reflecting the universal noble values of Pancasila and support tolerance towards national unity and integrity as well as global peace. In addition, student profiles show knowledge and thinking skills such as critical thinking, problem-solving, communication, cooperation, innovation, creativity, information literacy, noble, and moderate in religion (Akhmadi, 2023).

Students have the opportunity to "experience knowledge" as a process of strengthening their character through the Pancasila and Rahmatan lil Alamin Student Profile Strengthening Program. This program also allows them to learn from the environment around them (Suryaningsih & Desstya, 2023). The project-based learning model (PjBL) focuses student learning on this independent curriculum. PjBL strategies should help students develop their creativity in learning.

The project-based learning method (PjBL) focuses on completing assignments, especially with a project model that encourages students to actively participate in the writing and data collection process. However, no project is the same as another. Project-based and related instructions (Diana Sartika & Sulasmi Sulasmi, 2023). According to several studies, implementing project-based learning (PjBL) in learning has a better effect on its implementation. This can be the most effective alternative for implementing special mathematics learning. This is because Project Learning (PjBL), which focuses on students (student-centered), allows students to explore the knowledge they will learn through the application of projects and research. Because learning mathematics requires collaboration, it will increase student motivation, interest, ability, and interaction (Riani, 2023).

The aim of the Merdeka Curriculum is project-based learning (PjBl), which focuses on allowing students, teachers, and schools to freely choose the best learning. The term "Freedom to Learn" is a different concept from the 2013 curriculum, which means giving freedom to schools, teachers, and students to freely create, innovate, and learn independently. The development of this freedom begins with teacher encouragement. The learning environment is pleasant considering the many complaints from parents and students that learning requires minimum grades, especially during the pandemic. The Merdeka Curriculum does not require a minimum score of perfection. On the contrary, quality education is emphasized to produce students who have Pancasila character and are ready to face world challenges.

In PjBL, teachers and students have the opportunity to innovate in learning by choosing their projects. They will learn to be independent, and creative, and learn about Pancasila values. Activities in the PjBL strategy such as cooperation and critical reasoning enable students to learn Pancasila attitudes.

Disadvantages and Advantages of Implementing PPA-Based PAI Management

There are several advantages and disadvantages to PjBL-based learning. The following are the advantages of PjBL-based learning (Masti, 2022).

- a. Increase student motivation, by making them work hard to complete projects and find learning in a project more enjoyable than other parts of the curriculum.
- b. Students improve their problem-solving skills by using a variety of resources that demonstrate a project-based learning environment. This makes them more active and successful in solving complex problems.
- c. To increase collaboration and the importance of group work in projects, students must improve their communication skills.
- d. Providing learning experiences that engage students that are complex and designed to develop according to the real world. Creating a pleasant learning atmosphere so that both students and teachers enjoy the learning process.
- e. Improve students' skills in managing learning resources.

Weaknesses of PjBL-based learning:

- a. solving a problem through activities that are quite complex, requires a lot of time to complete it.
- b. To develop students' creative thinking abilities and create their activities and work, an in-depth study of the material is needed.
- c. It requires quite a lot of money to provide the tools or materials used. (Arya Hasan As'ari et al., 2022).

Evaluation of the Implementation of PAI Management Based on PJBL

Professional educators must carry out assessments or evaluations that are by learning objectives, adapt learning to assessments, and follow student progress based on assessment results. Teachers can assess student progress through tests, observations, assignments, and other necessary formats (Safrudin et al., 2023). The assessment or evaluation process can be carried out by educators in the following way:

- a. When educators create a learning implementation plan (RPP) based on a syllabus or teaching material module, they create an assessment strategy;
- b. To carry out attitude assessments, methods such as observation and other related assessments are used. The homeroom teacher or principal is responsible for the results;
- c. Written exams, oral exams, and assignments are some of the ways to assess knowledge;
- d. According to the competencies assessed, practices, products, projects, portfolios, and/or other techniques are used to assess skills;
- e. Remedial learning is required for students who have not reached the KKTP of the educational unit;
- f. The assessment results are used as a basis for providing feedback to students.

In this case, teachers must ensure that students know what their deficiencies are in acquiring their abilities, how to overcome their deficiencies, and that students are willing to take action to correct their deficiencies. Therefore, assessment will increase motivation and bring about better behavioral changes for students (R Adawiyah, 2022).

1. Planning

- e. Create a schedule: Create a clear timeline for each stage of the project.
- f. Provide resources: Make sure students have access to necessary materials and equipment.

2. Implementation

- a. Provide clear direction: Explain assignments, expectations, and grading rubrics to students.
- b. Guide and monitor progress: Provide support and constructive feedback to students throughout the project process.
- c. Encourage reflection: Help students to reflect on their learning process and the results obtained

3. Evaluation

- a. Formative assessment: using formative assessment to monitor student progress and provide ongoing feedback.
- b. Summative assessment: using summative assessment to assess the final results of the project and the student's level of understanding of the learning objectives.
